



# SIMULATOR OPERATOR MANUAL

Training system for security screening and theft detection

---

This manual provides a complete guide to the functions of the Theft Test simulator. The system is designed for advanced training of security screening operators, developing skills in analyzing metal detector indications, interacting with screened individuals, and making accurate decisions under stress.

## Screening Procedure (Step-by-Step)

---

### 1. Login and Shift Start

Enter your Name or Operator ID in the login window. The system logs the start time and tracks your screening statistics.

### 2. Analyzing Indicators (WTMD)

Observe the body silhouette on the screen. Red zones (Head, Torso, Pockets, Feet) indicate the exact location of metal detection.

### 3. Interacting with Subjects

Pay attention to the text box containing the subject's statements. Subjects may cooperate, but might also try to distract, stress, rush, or deceive you.

## 4. Item Verification

Instruct the person to place items from the alarming zones into the tray using the dedicated zone buttons.

## 5. Final Decision

Once the person is cleared of all dangerous/prohibited items and the alarm stops, pass the person or take disciplinary steps if smuggling was detected.

# Button Functions and Meanings

---

**HEAD / TORSO / POCKETS /  
FEET**

Command to place items from a specific body zone into the tray. Use according to the active alarm zone.

**MED. BADGE**

Medical documentation verification. Use when a person claims to have medical implants or a pacemaker.

 **RULE VIOLATION**

Report a facility rule violation. Use when a subject carries an item prohibited by internal rules (e.g., a lighter).

**PASS AGAIN**

Order the person to walk through the gate again after removing items to ensure no hidden items remain.

 **FORCE GATE  
VERIFICATION**

Forced procedure. Used when a person avoids the detection zone or the system requires a hard measurement reset.

 **STEP BACK / SINGLE FILE**

Response to 'Tailgating'. Use immediately when the system detects multiple people attempting to pass at once.

 **CALL COMMANDER**

Escalate the issue. Essential when obvious contraband (weapons, stolen parts) is detected or during aggressive behavior.

**PASS / RELEASE**

Positive conclusion of the procedure. No alarms are present, the person is clear to enter.
